

Melanie has written in the past on motherhood and marriage, but in this latest book, she explores the intricate relationship of female friendships. I laughed out loud through her first two books, Sparkly Green Earrings: Catching the Light at Every Turn and The Antelope in the Living Room: The Real Story of Two People Sharing One Life â " and this collection was no exception. However, in my opinion, Nobodyâ ™s Cuter Than You has an added depth and maturity. Itâ ™s filled with hilarious anecdotes, but the lessons gleaned about friendship are rich and full of wisdom. Throughout the book, Melanie aptly chronicles the whole gamut from early childhood bonds, to the awkward teen
