

# Oneida: From Free Love Utopia To The Well-Set Table





## Synopsis

A fascinating and unusual chapter in American history about a religious community that held radical notions of equality, sex, and religiona •only to transform itself, at the beginning of the twentieth century, into a successful silverware company and a model of buttoned-down corporate propriety.In the early nineteenth century, many Americans were looking for an alternative to the Puritanism that had been the foundation of the new country. Converted into a joint-stock company, Oneida Community, Limited, would go on to become one of the nationâ <sup>™</sup>s leading manufacturers of silverware, and their brand a coveted mark of middle-class respectability in pre- and post-WWII America. Told by a descendant of one of the Communityâ ™s original families, Ellen Wayland-Smith's Oneida is a captivating story that straddles two centuries to reveal how a radical, free-love sect, turning its back on its own ideals, transformed into a purveyor of the white-picket-fence American dream.

I'm an American Lit. teacher and lover of the weird and interesting people, cultures, and stories that fill our history. I also like good writing. I knew I was in for a treat when I read this on the second page of Oneida's intro, "As the twin dynamos of the market revolution and the Industrial Revolution were transfiguring the American landscape in the 1840s, John Humphrey Noyes and his followers energetically embraced capitalism and the technological wizardry of the modern era...as the wings that would bring fruition to the New Jerusalem." This seems to be Wayland-Smith's gift: taking seemingly disparate elements (capitalism and religion, sex and spirituality, advertising and proselytizing) and not simply drawing a connection, but showing how these elements coexist and evolve together to form America. The story itself is crazy and fascinating. If you enjoy books like Seabiscuit, Unbroken, The Boys in the Boat, Under the Banner of Heaven, H is for Hawk...books that bring together many characters, ideas, historical moments and make you feel like you see and understand, then Oneida is the book for you.

This is a fascinating book--a wild ride from free love utopia in New York to the silver kings of Oneida. Its great for American history buffs and an amazing family tale told by one of the descendants with the "inside" goods. I learned a lot about religion and advertising too. In beautifully drafted prose, Ellen Wayland-Smith draws us into a deep family history, telling American history at the same time. I have a feeling this book is going to be made into a TV series or movie. It is rare that I am so captivated by a book and learn so much. I can't wait for her next book.

This is an interesting book about a very interesting group of people. It is not written as a novel, however, which causes the story line to lag a bit for the average reader. The author has approached this story of her family and Oneida from a scholarly viewpoint and has a scholar's insights as to the social and historical implications of the Oneida Community. I found it very interesting.

The author is an English professor and this book reads as such. Lots of interesting insights, but don't expect an easy read. I found the sentences quite long and requiring full engagement. Also, she rambles a bit throughout philosophical and religious history.
